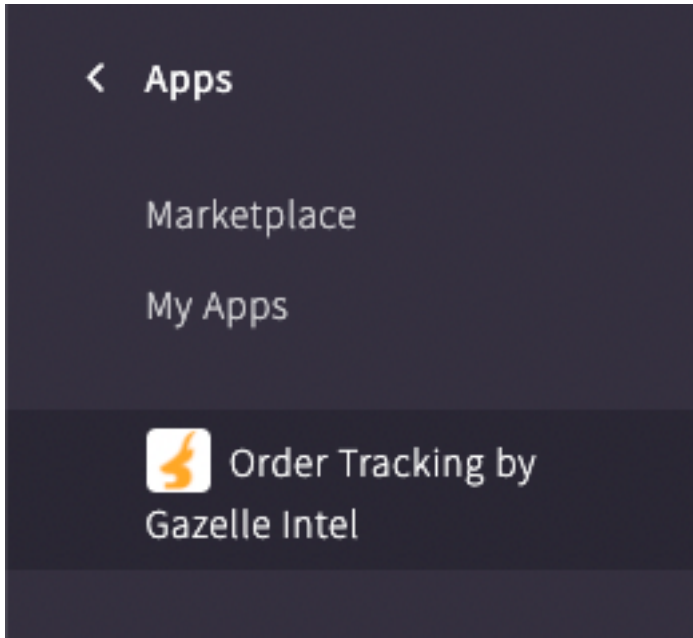



User Guide

2. Fill out your desired page name and page url, then click Create Page

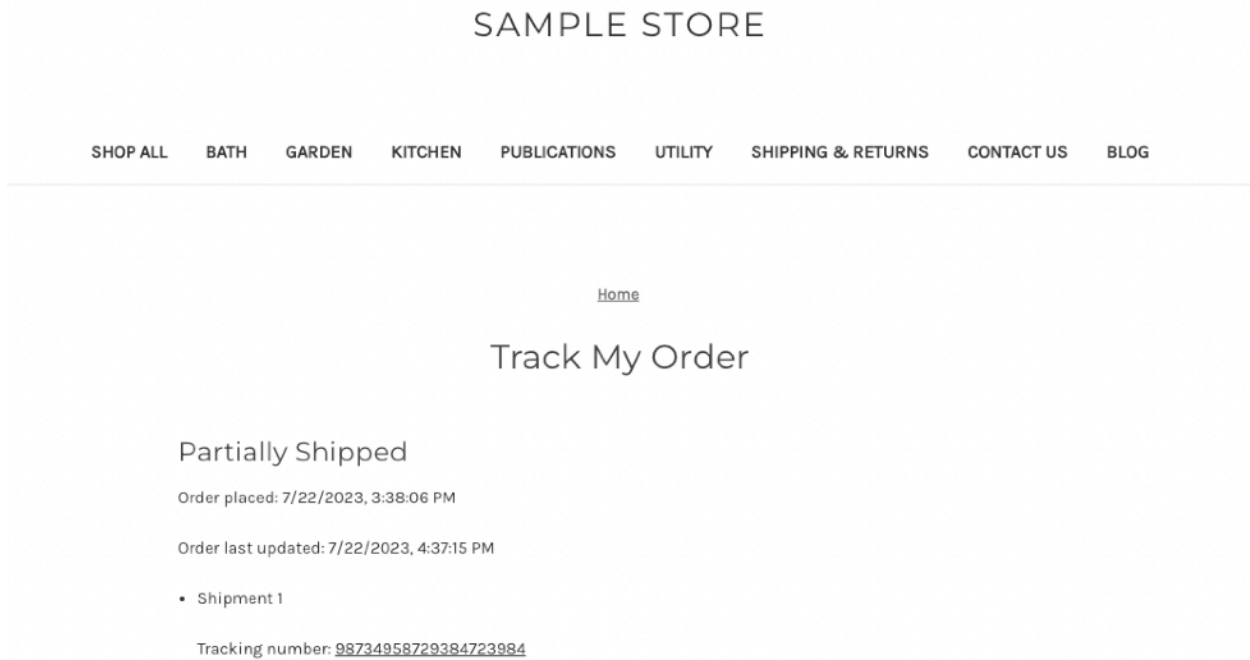

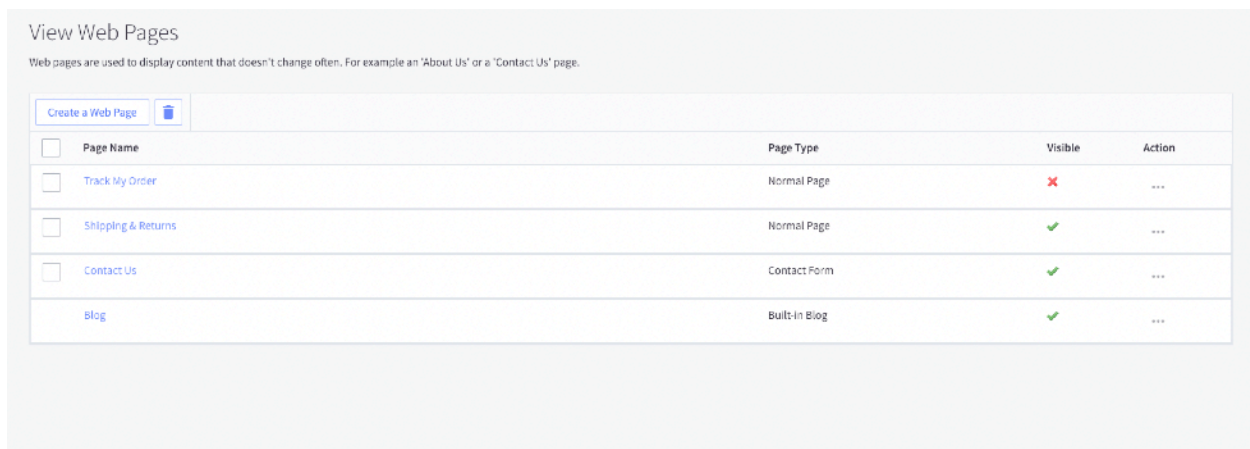
